

Sec. 10-6-17 Standards and Procedures for the Conduct of Specialized Commercial Flying Services

- (a) The Operator shall lease from the City an area of not less than five thousand (5000) square feet of ground space, on which shall be erected a building of not less than two thousand nine hundred (2,900) square feet.
- (b) In the case of crop dusting, aerial application, or other commercial use of chemicals, the Operator shall provide the City with all applicable permits and approvals as may be required by the Wisconsin Department of Natural Resources, the United States Environmental Protection Agency, or other applicable regulatory agency. Such facilities will be in a location on the airport which will provide the greatest safeguard to the public.
- (c) The Operator shall provide not less than one (1) aircraft which shall will be airworthy, meeting all requirements of the Federal Aviation Administration and applicable regulations of the State of Wisconsin with respect to the type of operations to be performed.
- (d) The Operator shall have in his/her employ, and available during the appropriate business hours, not less than one (1) person holding a current Federal Aviation Administration commercial certificate, properly rated for the aircraft to be used and the type of operation to be performed.
- (e) The Operator shall provide the City upon request with copies of the Owner's Aircraft Registration and Aircraft Lease Documents.
- (f) The following types of insurance are required:
 - a. Aircraft liability
 - b. Comprehensive public liability and comprehensive property damage, including vehicular.
